Reports are to be read aloud in class. Each student will take an AR Test on both of his/her books on our first library visit - required!

Describe the main conflict (what's the problem?) This should be at least a paragraph.

List in order the most important events in the book (there are more than 1).

What is the conclusion? How was the problem solved? **How did it end?** Explain it!

What was your favorite part of the book? Explain why.

Did you like the book? Explain why or why not?

On a separate page do the following vocabulary page: List, underline and define at least **5 words** or more that you did not know. This page is to be attached to the back of your report.
